1. Invitation for Tenders follows the General Procurement Notice (GPN) for this Project which appeared in Daily News Papers dated 12th August, 2016 and Emergency works for Upgrading of Emmaus – African Dream Road to Bituminous Standard (Airport Alternative route).
2. The Dodoma Municipal Council has received funds from the Road fund Board and European Union. It is intended that part of the proceeds of the fund will be used to cover eligible payments under the contract for the cost of Rehabilitation / Maintenance of Municipal roads and Upgrading of Emmaus – African Dream road into tarmac standard (AC) respectively as listed in the table below.
3. The Dodoma Municipal Council now invites sealed tenders from Local Civil Engineering Contractors registered with ‘Contractors Registration Board (Tanzania)’ in classes specified in the table below and who meet the qualification criteria stated in the Tender Documents.
